PACKSSCOLES FARM, PYNEST GREEN LANE, HIGH DERCH, WALTHAM AMBCY, ESSEX

WHEREAS:

- (1) The District Council of Epping Forest (hercinafter referred to as "the District Council") is the District Planning Authority under the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 (as amended by section 182 of the Local Government Act 1972) for the District of Epping Forest.
- (2) Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 (heroinafter called "the Order") permits the carrying out of certain development as specified in the first schedule to the Order upon land to which the Order applies without the permission of the District Council or the Socretary of State for the Environment.
- (3) Class V1-1 of the first schedule to the Order relates to the carrying out on agricultural land having an area of more than one acre and comprised in an agricultural unit of building or engineering operations requisite for the use of that land for the purposes of agriculture (other than the placing on land of structures not designed for those purposes or the provision and alteration of dwellings) so long as
 - (a) the ground area covered by a building erected pursuant to the permission does not, either by itself or after the addition thereto of the ground area covered by any existing building or buildings (other than a dwalling house) within the same unit erected or in the course of erection within the preceding two years and wholly or partly within 90 matres of the nearest part of the said building, exceed 465 square metres
 - (b) the height of any buildings or works done not exceed 3 metres in the case of a building or works within 3 kilometres of the perimeter of an nerodrome, nor 12 matres in any other case

- (c) no part of any buildings (other than movemble atmosteres) or works is within 25 matres of the motalled portion of a trust or chaosified road
- (4) Article 4 of the Order, enables withor the District Council or the Secretary of State for the Environment to direct that a permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to opecified development
- VI-1 of the first Schedule of the Order should not at any time be cerried out on the land hereinafter defined unless permission is granted on an application made pursuant to the provisions of the Order because the land forms part of a very attractive area within the Metropolitan Green Belt and the uncontrolled prection of buildings would have a disasterous effect on the landscape and would seriously affect the outlook and amenities of residential properties adjoining the land in the Wellington Hill area

NOW THEREFORE the District Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (1) of Article 4 of the Order DU HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to the development opecified in Class VI-1 of the first Schedule of the Order in respect of 13 acres of land forming part of Packsaddles Farm, Pynest Green Lane, High Beach, Waltham Abbey, in the district of Epping Forest more particularly delineated on the plan attached herete and thereon edged red. This direction shall require the approval of the Secretary of State for the Environment and shall come into force on the date on which the District Council serve a notice on the occupier or if no occupier the owner of the land stating the effect of the direction after approval of the Secretary of State


