### Epping Forest District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT Epping Forest District Council has made the above Order in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The general effect of the Order is as follows:

- a. To remove Cottis Lane Car Park, Epping from the Order.
- b. To introduce Cottis Yard Multi-Storey Car Park, Epping into the Order. The tariffs for the car park are shown below and shall apply Monday – Sunday 07:00 – 00:00.

<b>Monday to Sunday</b>	<b>Tariff</b>
Up to 1 hour	£1.00
Up to 2 hours	£2.00
Up to 3 hours	£3.00
Up to 4 hours	£4.00
Up to 5 hours	£5.00
Over 5 hours	£10.00

Maximum period of waiting will be 24 hours. There will be no charges on Saturdays/Sundays in December.

Season ticket prices:

<b>Duration</b>	<b>Tariff</b>
1 month	£170
3 months	£510
12 months	£2040

A maximum of 60 active season tickets to be issued.

- c. To remove Bakers Lane Car Park, Epping from the Order.
- d. To introduce Epping Leisure Centre Car Park, Epping into the Order. The days of operation are to be Monday – Sunday and the hours of operation of the parking place is to be line with Epping Leisure Centre operational hours. The maximum period of waiting will be 24 hours. This parking place will have no charge as parking will be Blue Badge holder parking only for leisure centre users (during operational hours).
- e. To remove Epping Sports Centre (Hemnall Street and Nicholl Road) Epping from the Order.
- f. To remove St Johns Road Car Park, Epping (Temporary Car Park) from the Order.

The Order will come into effect on 31 March 2025.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, may do so by application to the High Court within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made for the purpose.
