

## Wheelie Bin Charging Policy

The charging policy will not take place in the following circumstances.

- i. Issue of Medical bins
- ii. Issue of Recycling (blue lidded) bins for individual properties taking part in the wheelie bin trial.
- iii. Any repairs to individual properties (includes HMO's) of any bin. Repairs cover replacement lids, wheels, axles, lugs for lids.- it does <u>not</u> cover the actual carcass (body) of a bin.(This does not cover communal wheelie bins.)
- iv. Any resident who wants a bin smaller than a standard 180 litre and returns their current larger bin to us.

## **Individual Properties (includes HMO's)**

New residents – will be charged for all the wheelie bins as they should have been provided by the previous householder or developer.

New tenants - – will be charged for all the wheelie bins as they should have been provided by the previous tenant or land/property owner.

Any resident who applies for a larger bin and is successful will be charged for the assessment, issuing and delivery of refuse wheelie bin.

Replacement bins will be charged for if the bin is lost, stolen or damaged.

Replacement bins will be free of charge if the bin is provable as contractor damage.

## **Communal bins**

Flats & communal bin compounds – will be charged for all the wheelie bins and repairs.

## **New developments**

The developers are required to pay for all waste containers.
